2.6.2 Annual Report of Controller of Examinations highlighting Pass Percentage of students

End semester examinations of Alagappa University for the Academic Year 2022-2023 commenced on 28.04.2023 and ended on 26.05.2023. The digitalized infrastructure expedited the process of publication of results and the gap between the last date of exams and the last date of declaration of results in 2022-2023 stands at 93 per cent, 1874 students appeared for exams across all disciplines and the University achieved an overall pass percentage of 95 per cent.

An analysis of the programme wise break up of results indicate that 40 out of 63 programmes have achieved cent per cent results; in 16 programmes the pass per cent is more than 90percent. These exceptional pass percentages showcase the dedication and hardwork of both students and faculty members. These results are a testament to the quality of education and rigorous academic standards of Alagappa University.
